Over the past five years the Adapted Cognitive Assessment Lab (ACAL) has focused its research on adapted cognitive assessments for children with cerebral palsy (CP). Through the ACAL, researchers have effectively assisted parents and educators of children with CP by providing them with accurate information about each child's cognitive abilities. These findings contribute to promoting appropriate supports in school, home, and community settings for these children and their families.
